



Announcement of the Council of Bunditpatanasilpa Institute of Fine Arts
English Proficiency Assessment Criteria
for Doctoral Degree Students
B.E. 2568 (2025)

As it deemed appropriate to establish criteria for assessing the English language proficiency of Doctoral degree students in accordance with the Announcement of Higher Education Standards Committee on the Graduate Program Standards B.E. 2565 (2022),

By virtue of Section 17 (2) of the Bunditpatanasilpa Institute of Fine Arts Act B.E. 2550 (2007) and Clause 25 (4) (B) of the Regulations of Bunditpatanasilpa Institute of Fine Arts on Graduate Studies Administration, B.E. 2567 (2024), in conjunction with the resolution of the Council of Bunditpatanasilpa Institute of Fine Arts in Meeting No. 2/2025 held on March 6, 2025, hereby announces the following:

Clause 1 This announcement shall be referred to as the "Announcement of the Council of Bunditpatanasilpa Institute of Fine Arts on English Proficiency Assessment Criteria for Doctoral Degree Students B.E. 2568 (2025)."

Clause 2 This announcement shall come into force starting from the Academic Year B.E. 2567 (2024)

Clause 3 Doctoral degree students who have obtained English language proficiency test score from recognized language testing institution, with results valid for no more than two years from the date of test results until the date of student application, shall not be required to enroll in English courses if their scores meet the following criteria:


Clause 4 Doctoral degree students whose English proficiency test scores from recognized language testing institution do not meet the criteria specified in Clause 3 must enroll in the additional English course, "Pre-sessional English for Doctoral Students."

Clause 4 Doctoral degree students whose English proficiency test scores from recognized language testing institution do not meet the criteria specified in Clause 3 must enroll in the additional English course, "Pre-sessional English for Doctoral Students."

Clause 5 In cases where doctoral degree students do not have an English language proficiency test score from recognized language testing institution, or whose test scores are more than two years from the date of results, must enroll in the additional English course as specified in Clause 4.

Clause 6 Students who are currently enrolled in the additional English course but subsequently obtain an English language proficiency test score from recognized language testing institution that meets the criteria in Clause 3 may submit their results to Bunditpatanasilpa Institute of Fine Arts. Upon verification, such students shall be exempted from further enrollment in the additional English language course.
